

**Federal Election Commission Rules  
Guidelines for Contributions to  
Vietnam Veterans Against John McCain  
A Non-Connected Political Action Committee**

Contributions which total \$200.00 or less to Vietnam Veterans Against John McCain (VVAJM) in a calendar year are not reportable to the Federal Election Commission or any other regulatory body.

Maximum donation of \$5,000 per person can be made to this PAC in a calendar year:

Married couples can each give a \$5,000 donation from one checking account however, if a contribution -- larger than \$5,000 and no more than \$10,000 -- is given in a single check, both signatures are required on that check.

Children of all ages can give up to \$5,000 each as long as it is from their own checking account.

In order to prevent the unlawful "bundling" or "pass-through" political contributions by corporations, donations of more than \$200.00 in a calendar year require the following:

Full name (Last, First, Middle Initial) and address

Name of Employer (print on the check FOR line, lower left corner)

Occupation (print on the check FOR line, lower left corner)

The name and address requirement for all payments is to ensure that one person making multiple contributions in a calendar year does not exceed the \$5,000 maximum limit and that total contributions greater than \$200 in a calendar year are reported.

Government contractors, corporations and labor organizations are not allowed to donate to this Non-connected PAC fund.

Contributions are **NOT tax deductible** and cash donations cannot exceed \$100. **Anonymous cash donation cannot exceed \$50.**
